Stop 1

**FIRST ROLLERCOASTER IN WABASH CO.**

## West Cooper Road - Richvalley

## Intersection on 700 W & Old 124, Wabash

## 7877 W 400 N, Wabash

David Doud's Countyline Orchard founded in 1989 has the perfect county setting. With delicious apples, pears, and strawberries, this is a "Must See" in Wabash County.

**KNOWN AS THE ROANN ROLLER MILL**

## 6071 N 800 W, Roann

Built in 1855, the Stockdale Mill continues to provide free tours throughout the summer and offers freshly milled flour for purchase. The mill is powered by a 202 foot long dam that spans the Eel River.

**ALL SEASON FARM**

## 9559 N 250 W, Roann

## 400-498 S Mill St, North Manchester

## 10373 N 300 E, North Manchester
